

# **BRIEF HISTORY**

**Centre for Information Tech (CINTEC)** was established on the 10th of September, 1997 the year which heralded a new era in Computer Education in the State. The Institute got registered as an Institutional Trust under the Indian Trust Act, 1882. Although success was not an easy task, overcoming all obstacles we have succeeded in consolidating our position and today we are proud to be one of the BEST in the State. Over the last 10 years, the Information Technology in India has reached a sort of crescendo. In order to be at par with the growing needs of our country's technological advancements, Computer Literacy is a must today.

Since the increasing job prospects and opportunities are too large to be met by formal institutions having long course schedules, non-formal education and training has to be resorted to. This requirement has initiated students to seek standard institutions offering high quality courseware, curriculum and short course schedules among the non-formal institutions.

Professional orientation and sound teaching methodology has elevated CINTEC a Computer Institute of Pre-eminence. The courses offered are lucid and comprehensive specially designed to provide & enhance job oriented skills. The informal atmosphere of the Centre permits constant interaction with the faculty which

in turn offers a harmonious learning environment which is very essential for assimilation of Computer Education. CINTEC also prepares its students for the National Level Examinations approved by the All India Council for Technical Education and conducted by the DoEACC Society twice in a year.

The basic objective of the Institute is to boost up students with upto-date knowledge and skills as well as scientific temperament so as to feed the ever increasing demand for Information Technology personnels in the State in particular and North East Region in general.

# **ACTIVITIES REPORT**

The tiny State of Manipur with a population of 20 lakhs approximately is far behind in terms of development compared to other States in the country. The problems in the State is compounded with the increasing number of unemployed youths totalling about 3.5 lakhs. Various agencies of the Government as well as non-Government Organisations have been taking up multifarious programmes for the people so that they may be able to be self-employed or gainfully employed as employment opportunities in the Government sector has become virtually impossible. In the present context, being a Computer literate has become almost a necessity and also an added qualification for an individual to be employed or be self-employed.

In view of the above stated problems being faced in the State, particularly in the employment sector, the Institute has been taking a vital role in imparting computer training to all sections in the State without regards to caste, creed, sex and religion so as to enable them to get self-employment or sustainable employment. In this process, the Institute had been conducting many long term and short term courses. The courses so far conducted by the Institute are lucid and comprehensive specially designed to provide and enhance job oriented skills.

It can be seen that, during the year of report, the total number of students so far trained by the Institute were 153.

### **NEW COURSES INTRODUCED :**

Apart from the existing syllabus, the Institute is introducing new courses to meet the shortage of more sophisticated trained personnels in Information Technology. Different streams of contemporary knowledge is now introduced by including the courses on **Graphic Designing, 2D Animation, Audio & Video Editing, WebPage Designing, Advance WebPage Designing, Diploma in WebSite Development and Programming in C/C++, SQL 7.0, Visual Basic, ASP, JAVA** etc.

## **LINKAGES THROUGH SPONSORSHIP WITH GOVT. DEPARTMENTS & ORGANIZATIONS :**

The sponsorship programme which was initiated and conducted in collaboration with different NGOs, VOs, Government Departments, Associations etc. are still going on.

The expanding networks of CINTEC during the last few years reflect the growth and credibility of the institution, the faith reposed by the Government authorities and other Government run Departments in the Institute. In the service of Information Technology for the State of Manipur, the Institute had been able to provide additional facilities for training of special categories of deputed students for employed personnels of Government Departments during the last few years.

Mention may be made for the sponsored programme of conducting 6 months *Crash Course in Computer Application* under the **World Vision of India, Imphal-ADP** in their Area Development Programme from September, 2001 to March, 2002 as a 3rd batch of the training. Altogether 40 sponsored students comprising both boys and girls belonging to different communities were trained under this programme by the Institute.

The Institute is now engaged as an ongoing programme in conducting *Computer Application and Programming Course*, the duration of which runs for a period of 6 (six) months, under

The Institute is also associated with the Department of Youth Affairs & Sports, Government of Manipur at present. Faculties are deputed by the Institute to the State Youth Centre, Khuman Lampak Sports Complex, Imphal for Computer Training of their staff and youths deputed by different Organisations, Associations and local Clubs.

The Institute is presently associated with the **National Informatics Centre, Imphal East District** for computerisation of Land Records of Imphal East District, Manipur by deputing one staff of the Institute along with a Computer System for Computerisation of Land Records.

### **NEW BUILDING OF CINTEC :**

In the rapid demands for better infrastructures, accommodation of students and modern facilities of institutional learning, the Institute has now shifted its entire complex to a

large pucca Building covering an area of 2000 square feet, adjacent to the old complex. The new building has now six partitioned rooms including **Lab. Room, Staff Room, Class Room, Visitor's Room, Service Room** and the **Director's Office**. The new building was inaugurated on the 31st December, 2001 by **Shri S. Birendra Singh, Director, CEDTI**, Imphal and **Shri Y. Irabot Singh, Chairman, CINTEC** as Chief Guest and President respectively.
